Step 1: Both the visitor and the visitee (resident) must be fully vaccinated (***FV**). (Day 1 is taken as the day of the final dose of the vaccination and Day 15 is taken as the day the vaccination is effective, Day 15 = fully vaccinated)

*FV: Fully Vaccinated or Recovered from COVID 19 and within 270 days from date of first detection.

Step 2: Visitor must have a valid visitation booking - Scheduled with our Medical Social Worker (3 working days in advance of the visit)

(No walk in request for visitation allowed)

Step 3: Visitor must produce a verifiable, negative ART result obtained within 24 hours before visiting.

For visitors recovered from COVID 19 within the last 270 days from the date of the scheduled visit will be required to produce their COVID 19 discharge memo (Paper or SMS). Security officer to sight the visitation date is within 270 days from the COVID 19 detected date.

Visitor must comply at all times to adhere to the Safe Management Measures e.g. strictly no mask down activities within the ward at all times, to restrict to visitor zone only for residents that are wheelchair bounded or ambulant. Visitation will ceased immediately for non compliance visitors and potentially barred from visitation.
